The work is divided into three distinct parts:

- State law surveys
- U.S. Supreme Court and federal circuit court surveys
- Subject-Specific Surveys

Each individual listing contains the most current title of the annual or survey. (Significant title changes are indicated in the "Notes" section). The name of the law review is provided, followed by an indication of authorship. The "Notes" section also describes the purpose and scope of the survey, as well as its frequency and arrangement.

In all, more than 130 annuals and surveys are listed, covering 34 states, 14 federal courts, and 45 subject areas.

This affordable research tool will save time and increase awareness of the vast number of annuals and surveys available to researchers, librarians, professors, and students.

Notes: The Survey covers the prior term and includes a scholarly discussion of major subject areas. The "Statistics" section includes tables covering actions of individual judges; voting alignments; unanimity; 5-4 decisions; final disposition of cases and method of disposition; subject matter disposition with full opinions. The Survey also includes a section of specific federal acts, i.e. Administrative Procedure Act, Atomic Energy Act, Securities Act, etc. The commentary is comparative and shows historical development of the cases selected and circuit conflicts. Editorial interpretation and comprehensive coverage make this Survey noteworthy. The Survey has appeared annually since 1951. Table of Cases.
