In the late 1960s and early 1970s, a flurry of state and federal legislation followed the Civil Rights Act of 1964 to protect women from gender discrimination in various areas of their lives. This legislation affirmed the idea that women – as a class – have a constitutional right to equal protection under the law in the United States. Yet thirty years later, experts in fields of gender, equality, and the law continue to write and debate about the extent to which this equal protection exists.

After a collaborative class project in collection development and eight years of exhaustive research, Loretta Price compiled *An Explosive Quarter-Century*, an extensive and well-organized bibliography which cites **thousands** of monographic materials covering the immense range of concerns and issues that are of interest to all feminist legal scholars and activists. The work includes nearly **10,000 citations** under a wide array of subject headings, with many books cross-referenced so that they can be easily located.

This bibliography references **hundreds of topics** that relate to women and their legal rights, including reproductive rights, domestic violence, language and literature, legal education, sexual harassment, political participation, social history, racism, and feminist legal theory.

Price's work is also valuable for another reason - while journal articles in most scholarly publications are indexed and abstracted by the authors to facilitate easy retrieval from online databases or periodical indexes, the same ability to identify monographs is not available. *An Explosive Quarter-Century* focuses on monographic materials, directing the researcher to works that cannot easily be found using other resources.

*An Explosive Quarter-Century* cites works published since 1975, picking up where Marija Matich Hughes left off in her 1977 work *The Sexual Barrier: Legal, Medical, Economic and Social Aspects of Sex Discrimination*, which provided a comprehensive bibliography on women's rights from 1960-1975. **This title is also available from Hein (see below).**

By providing access to this literature and its information, *An Explosive Quarter-Century* is an indispensable work for those instructors, researchers, legal scholars, and students seeking information about women and the vast array of status issues that affect them.
