Aviation Law is one of the most expansive and complex topics within the law. With issues including labor struggles, liability for crashes, and looming concerns about terrorism, aviation has become a highly regulated field, more so than Wilbur and Orville Wright could have ever envisioned when they launched the first powered flight more than a century ago.

Wendy B. Davis's *Aviation Law: Cases and Problems*, discusses the legal implications of flying as they relate to potential liabilities for pilots, air traffic controllers, airport designers, the FAA, and others, and the consequences that can result from a lack of attention, expertise, or experience.

This **superior** legal casebook provides law students with a comprehensive foundation in the many legal issues connected with the operation of both private and commercial aircraft and the airports that they use. Chapters address administrative law, tort law, government liability, international treaties, terrorism, the environmental impact of airports, and many other matters.

Each chapter includes revisions of several cases, all of which illustrate a point of law related to the chapter topic. Statutes and regulations are reprinted where appropriate, and each case is followed by notes that include questions designed to enlarge the reader's knowledge of the topic, with citations to cases for further reading.

While intended for use by law school elective classes offered to second and third year law students, this work will also aid military schools (such as the U.S. Air Force Academy, which includes legal courses for pilots) and paralegal schools. A glossary of aviation terms is included at the end of the book, and a complimentary teacher's manual is available for professors. *Aviation Law: Cases and Problems* is an exceptional resource for any researcher interested in aviation law!
