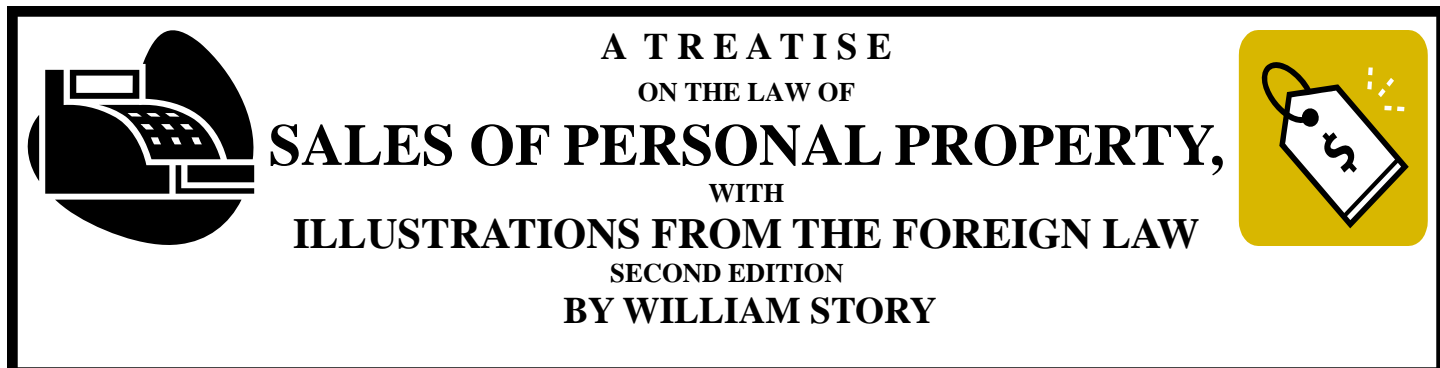

*The First American Work on Personal Property Sales Law!*



Story's was the **first comprehensive American treatise** on the law of sales of personal property. An accomplished legal writer (other Story works include *Treatise on the Law of Contracts Not Under Seal* and *The Life and Letters of Joseph Story*, a compilation of the writings of his noted jurist father) he eventually left the law and became a world-famous American sculptor and poet.

Following graduation from Harvard Law School, Story immersed himself in the study of American jurisprudence, with the publication of his treatise on contracts in 1844, and the first edition of *Treatise on the Law of Sales of Personal Property* in 1847. The publication was heralded by the legal community in particular for the inclusion of its comparison with foreign cases in respect to Foreign Law, Roman Law and Common Law.

The purpose of his revised work, Story noted in the *Preface* to the Second Edition, was to provide a full treatise on the whole body of law relating to sales of personal property as it existed at the time in both America and England, with references also made to the laws of France and Scotland.
