This work encompasses the establishment of the first United States Court in the Indian Territory in 1889, and continues through 1912, annotating each Act of Congress having a major impact upon the daily lives of the “Five Civilized (Cherokee, Chickasaw, Choctaw, Creek and Seminole) Tribes” of Oklahoma and the Osage Nation. Compiled and edited by C. L. Thomas, of the prominent Muskogee law firm Ramsey and Thomas, the book also incorporates all subsequent significant Acts, parts of Acts, Treaties and Agreements of “more than mere local, temporary or individual significance, pertaining to the affairs” of those affected, according to its Preface.

All reported decisions of the Indian Territory Courts are included, along with those of the Supreme Court of Oklahoma since statehood, and the Federal Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, the Circuit Court of Appeals and the United States Supreme Court. The Acts are readily found in a chronological listing, an alphabetical index of cases cited and a separate section devoted to the laws of inheritance. Legal research in Native American law for this period could not be simpler! Order from Hein today!
