

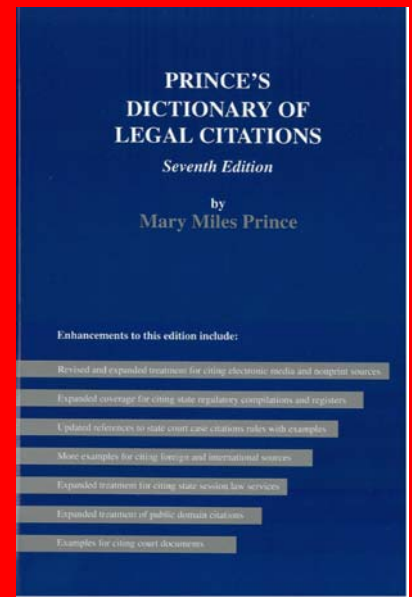

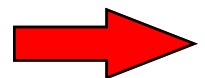

One of the most significant resources for legal researchers, librarians and practitioners, *Prince's Dictionary of Legal Citations, 7th Edition* is intended to assist the legal profession in citing legal authorities according to the rules given in *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation, 18th Edition* (2005). Prince's work is designed to be a companion to *The Bluebook*, not a replacement. It applies *Bluebook* rules to a representative collection of common legal authorities, with citations and abbreviations found in *The Bluebook* or derived from its guidelines.

This new edition is revised to include a wealth of new information and examples, including those for citing "depublished" cases, IRS Private Letter Rulings, PLI course handbooks and more. The section concerning electronic media has also been revised and now has examples for citing blogs and Web sites. Public domain information has been updated and includes additional domestic jurisdictions which now employ this form of citation. *Prince's Dictionary, 7th Edition* also provides new contributions from Bernard J. Sussman, Law Librarian, United States Court of Appeals for Veterans Claims, updating tables and numbering systems for federal legislation, the *Congressional Record*, the *United States Statutes at Large* and the *Federal Register*.



Although *The Bluebook* strives to establish uniformity in citation form for court documents, those utilizing it should remember that citation rules contained in local rules, state supreme court rules, rules of trial or appellate procedure, and statutes supersede *The Bluebook* rules. Prince's Dictionary assists users in determining which rules apply.
