The United States has the most complete and efficient system for documentation of treaty law of any country in the world. The United States Department of State compiles an annual list of all bilateral and multilateral agreements which are considered to be in whole or part in force for the United States as of January 1st of the relevant year, entitled *Treaties in Force*. Of course, it is not a comprehensive research tool, but instead, consists of two lists, one which deals with bilateral agreements and the other with multilateral agreements arranged by country and alphabetical order.

Recognizing the need for access to the current United States treaty law through a variety of retrieval approaches, this *Guide to the United States Treaties in Force* provides access to currently operative bilateral and multilateral agreements of the United States from a variety of perspectives.
