# Introduction

As the law librarian at a public law school library that also serves as the Pulaski County Law Library in Little Rock Arkansas, I had found the *World Law School Directory* to be a very useful reference tool. I became involved with compiling this new third edition of the *Directory* because I wanted it to continue to be a useful research source for the entire legal community. Prospective students, law firms recruiting new talent, and legal researchers seeking information about law schools in other lands are all members of the community who can benefit from this work.

Obtaining information on law schools in distant parts of the world is not easy, making the publishing of this directory difficult. I spent many hours on the Internet finding schools from every country seeming to have one. We sent multiple questionnaires to each school. If a school did not respond, we have so indicated on each entry. *(If a school did not respond to the surveys sent since 1999, its name is preceded by an asterisk [\*]; if a school has never responded to one of our surveys, its name is preceded by a pound symbol [#].)*

This edition has added more than 500 entries to the number found in the second edition, which was published in 1998. The number of entries for India, for example, increased from 218 to more than 500. Similarly, Brazil's entries increased from 46 to nearly 190 as a result of online research and personal contacts. As before, the listings include schools that are general colleges and universities offering courses in legal studies.

As with past editions, this edition includes e-mail addresses and web sites where we could identify them. There is an index by school name, allowing the user to find a school without having to know the country in which it is located. In this third edition we have made every effort to provide the most current and complete information possible.

As always, any further information you can provide to make future editions more inclusive would be welcomed and warmly appreciated.
